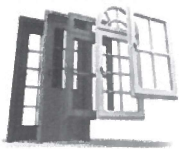
## Want to become involved in your community?

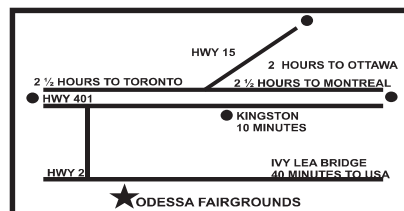
